

ROSE BRADER COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Established in honor of Rosalie Brader, this award has been presented annually since 1980. Rosalie Brader served our community as Director of Labor Participation at United Way for 31 years and offered her services in the interest of a variety of community efforts. This award is the highest for adult volunteerism presented by United Way of Wyoming Valley and honors an individual for outstanding local volunteer service.
